## Registered Shoot Memorandum of Agreement

The Director for the \_\_\_\_\_ Region, NBRSA, has tentatively awarded your club the following dates for National Bench Rest Shooters Association registered shoots. **List match dates and types of competition at the bottom half of page 2.**

To make these dates definite and official, read this agreement and the NBRSA Rulebook carefully. In the space marked "Accepted" have an officer of your club sign all three (3) copies. Mail all three (3) copies to the Director for your Region. When received and if properly signed, the Regional Director will sign in the space marked "Dates Approved". One (1) copy will then be sent to your Club, one (1) copy will be sent to NBRSA National Headquarters, and the Regional Director will retain one (1) copy.

(1) The \_\_\_\_\_ Club shall indemnify and save harmless NBRSA, its directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers and representatives from any and all liabilities, damages, losses, claims and expenses of any kind, including without limitation, attorneys' fees and court costs, resulting from, arising out of or in connection with, the registered shoots which are the subject of this Memorandum of Agreement.

(2) The Club agrees to abide by all applicable rules of the NBRSA. **Mandatory: Clubs must have weight sets at a match** in order to host NBRSA Registered Matches. If no weights are present and a possible World Record is shot, it can not be considered for a World Record.

(3) This Memorandum of Agreement shall be governed by, construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. With respect to any and all claims, disputes or controversies arising under, out of, or in connection with this Agreement or future agreements of a similar nature, the parties hereby agree that any such dispute shall be solely justifiable in the Federal or state courts located in the State of New York.

(4) To defray expenses of the NBRSA for statistical records and record measurements, the Club agrees to pay the NBRSA a registration fee for every individual shooter who fires in one or more matches on one or more dates listed herein. The fee to the NBRSA to be as follows:

**Each Competitor - \$2.00 per day**

**Mandatory NBRSA Membership and possession of current NBRSA ID Card is required.** The above fees must be paid or the shoot will not be recognized as a **Registered Shoot**. The fees must be paid whether the Club collects them from the competitor or not. The Club will be required to check all cards at time of registration to make sure each competitor is a current NBRSA member. Clubs will be billed by the NBRSA for any discrepancies in fees remitted.
